Art Homework

For each hour of class credit you earn, you may earn one hour credit doing homework. All written work must be in complete sentences and proper paragraph format, as well as neat and legible preferably in ink. You may choose the type of work you would prefer to do from the following list of homework options.

You must checkout all homework materials from *Ginger*.

I will not accept any incomplete work.

ArtTalk Textbook: Checkout book from *Ginger*. For each chapter you will read the chapter and answer all the Chapter Review questions at the end of the chapter. Possible credit for each chapter can range from 2 to 4 hours depending on the quality of your work. There are 12 chapters.

Basic Skills Handouts: These are great for students with few drawing skills that want to learn to draw. They are simple but, must be done carefully to gain any skill improvement or to earn credit of 1 to 3 hours each.

Drawing Handouts: These require a range of drawing skills from basic to advanced. The credit possible varies from 1 to 6 hours each.

Gallery Visit: Get a worksheet from *Ginger* before you go. There are several places to see original art in Elk Grove and many in Sacramento. *Ginger* has a list of places. Pick one to visit and fill out the worksheet while you are there. This earns 6 hours credit. You may earn double the credit (or more depending on quality of work) if you also write an essay describing the experience.

Artist Profile Essay: Research information about a historical artist (Ginger has a list to choose from) by reading a book about the artist and doing Internet research. Ginger has an outline of the type of information you must include. You must write this essay in MLA format and include a bibliography with web addresses and a print out of web information. If you plan to go to college I strongly suggest you try this project as it will improve your writing skills. I will provide help and guidance as needed. You may earn from 12 to 36 hours credit depending on the quality of work.

Other - with prior approval: If you have an idea for a project you would like to try, great. Write a brief description of your idea and turn it in to me. If I determine it is appropriate for Art credit we can then discuss the credit you may earn before you start the project.
