**SPEED**

- 22350 – UNSAFE SPEED FOR CONDITIONS, INCLUDES 25 MPH WHEN CHILDREN ARE PRESENT
- 22400 – IMPEDING TRAFFIC

**TURNS**

- 22103 – U TURN IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, VEHICLES APPROACHING WITHIN 200 FEET.
- 22100(a) – IMPROPER POSITION, RIGHT TURN.
- 22100(b) – IMPROPER POSITION, LEFT TURN

**CELL PHONE-WIRELESS DEVICE**

- 23123 – ADULT USE OF HANDHELD WIRELESS TELEPHONE WHILE DRIVING (MAY USE HANDS FREE DEVICE)  
  
23123.5- **TEXTING**-DRIVING WHILE USING WIRELESS DEVICE TO SEND READ OR WRITE A TEXT
- 23124 – USE OF HANDHELD WIRELESS TELEPHONE AND/OR HANDS FREE DEVICE BY DRIVER UNDER 18

**RESTRAINTS**

- 27315(d) – DRIVER SEATBELT NOT WORN OR ALLOW PASSENGER OVER 16 YEARS OF AGE TO NOT WEAR SEATBELT.
- 27315(e) – PASSENGERS 16 YEARS AND OVER NOT WEARING SEATBELT.
- 27360 – CHILD SEATS, MUST BE 6 YEARS OLD OR 60 POUNDS TO BE OUT OF SEAT. MUST BE SEATED IN THE REAR OF VEHICLE.

**PEDESTRIANS**

- 21950(a) – FAIL TO YIELD FOR PEDESTRIANS IN CROSSWALK (MARKED OR NOT)
- 21950(b) – PEDESTRIANS UNNECESSARILY DELAY TRAFFIC.
- 21954 – PEDESTRIANS OUTSIDE OF CROSSWALK MUST YIELD TO APPROACHING TRAFFIC.
- 21955 – JAYWALKING BETWEEN CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS

**STOPPING**

- 22450 – FAIL TO STOP AT STOP SIGN
- 22454 – FAIL TO STOP FOR SCHOOL BUS, LOADING AND UNLOADING.

**PARKING (OCCUPIED OR NOT)**

- 22500
  - (a) – WITHIN INTERSECTIONS.
  - (b) – BLOCKING CROSSWALK.
  - (e) – BLOCKING DRIVEWAY.
  - (h) – DOUBLE PARKED.
  - (i) – BUS ZONE.
- 22500.1 – FIRE LANE.
- 22502(a) – PARALLEL, MORE THAN 18” FROM CURB.
