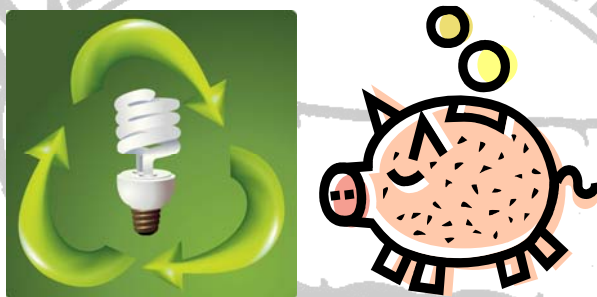

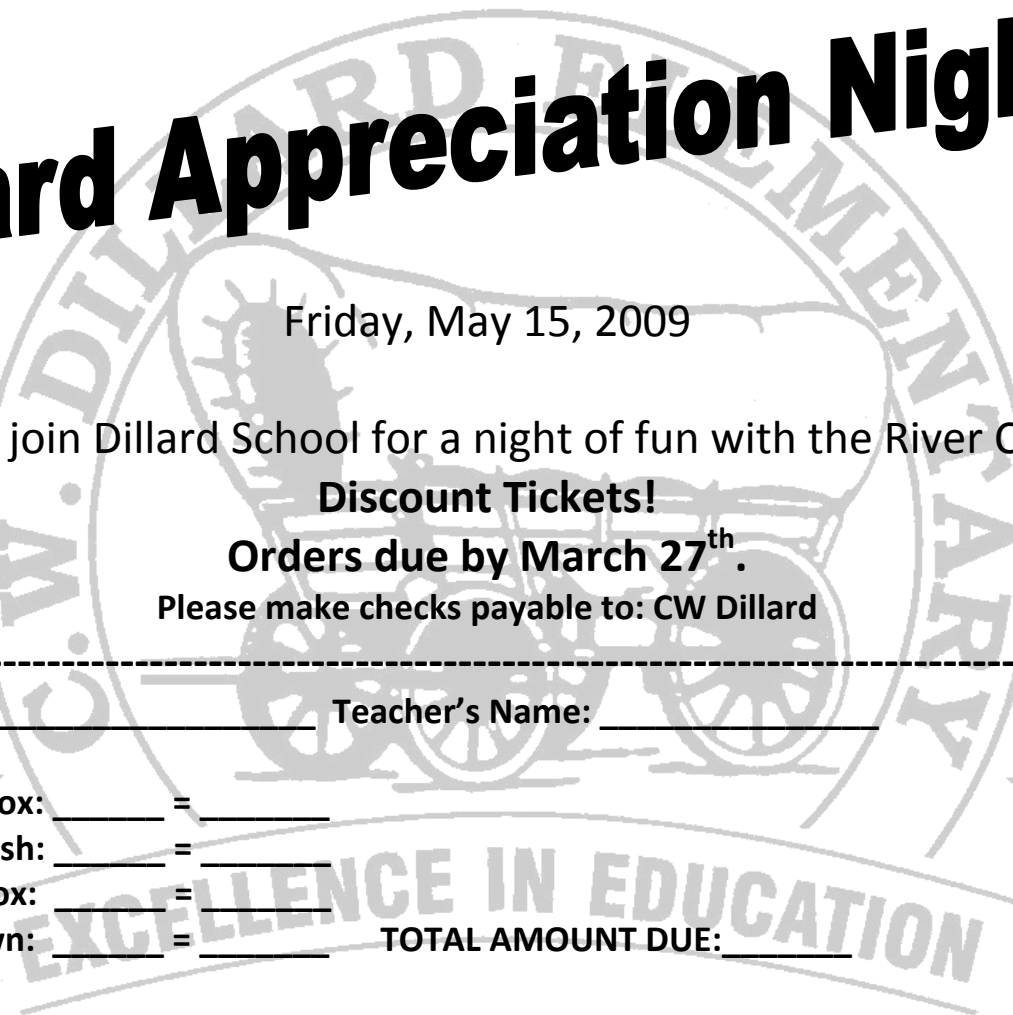

Ask Anne & Lisa

This month, in honor of National Nutrition Month, instead of answering a question, we would like to share with you the American Dietetics Association's suggestions for Healthy Snacks for Kids. During National Nutrition Month®, the American Dietetic Association reminds everyone that *Eating Right* and staying fit are important no matter what your age. Help yourself to feel your best by making healthy food choices and being physically active every day.

1. Peel a banana and dip it in yogurt. Roll in crushed cereal and freeze.
2. Inside Out Sandwich: Spread mustard on a slice of deli turkey. Wrap around a sesame breadstick.
3. Stuff a wholegrain pita pocket with ricotta cheese and Granny Smith apple slices. Add a dash of cinnamon.
4. Mix together ready-to-eat cereal, dried fruit and nuts in a sandwich bag for an on-the-go snack.
5. Smear a scoop of frozen yogurt on two graham crackers and add sliced banana to make a yummy sandwich.
6. Top low fat vanilla yogurt with crunchy granola and sprinkle with blueberries.
7. Toast a whole grain waffle and top with low fat yogurt and sliced peaches.
8. Microwave a small baked potato. Top with reduced fat cheddar cheese and salsa.
9. Make snack kabobs. Put cubes of low fat cheese and grapes on pretzel sticks.
10. Mix together peanut butter and cornflakes in a bowl. Shape into balls and roll in crushed graham crackers.
11. Sprinkle grated Monterey Jack cheese over a corn tortilla; fold in half and microwave for twenty seconds.
Top with salsa.
12. Make a mini-sandwich with tuna or egg salad on a dinner roll.
13. Blend low fat milk, frozen strawberries and a banana for thirty seconds for a delicious smoothie.
14. Spread mustard on a flour tortilla. Top with a slice of turkey or ham, low fat cheese and lettuce.
Then roll it up.
