

**Middle School Summer School:** For students currently in 6<sup>th</sup>- 8<sup>th</sup> grade who need English language arts or math intervention instruction; current 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who need to make up credit to meet promotion requirements; current 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> grade students who want to enroll in a class for enrichment. Students are to attend summer school at the middle school they currently attend.



**There are two registration periods:**

- **Priority registration: March 14 – April 13, 2007** for students who need intervention classes or to make up credit
- **Final registration: May 14 – May 25, 2007** for enrichment, intervention and make-up credit

**Enrollment Priorities:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> priority: District students who currently attend an EGUSD school and need English language arts intervention instruction to meet district grade level
- 2<sup>nd</sup> priority: District students who currently attend an EGUSD school and need make-up credit to promote
- 3<sup>rd</sup> priority: District students who currently attend an EGUSD school and enroll for enrichment
- 4<sup>th</sup> priority: Non- district students who need intervention instruction or make-up credit in core academic courses

**Courses Offered:** All schools will offer English language arts and math intervention. Courses for make-up credit and enrichment will vary from school to school. Check your school's summer school registration form for specific courses.
