- **Meeting called to order by Susan Cooper-Start**
- **Reading of March 30, 2005 minutes by Sue McIntosh; they were approved.**
- **Old Business**
 1. **Budget...Mrs. Dwairi suggested that departments need to check on their possible needs for start-up next school year. Money left over this year was approx. 5-6 K. Next year, because of smaller ADA income, we will have less money. Departments have been stocking up and we have put money into technology.**
 2. **STAR Testing Comments...Mrs. Dwairi reported that the classes were focused and compliments go out to Mrs. Peterson, Vice Principal, and the Counseling Staff for a job well done!**
 3. **Mrs. Winter...Library Report...Sandra inquired about using SIP money for library supplies. Mrs. Dwairi suggested General Fund money be used. As to library activities...Sandra shared the following:**
 - **There was an Adult and Kid's Book Club this year!**
 - **7th Graders are researching for "report of information" projects**
 - **Approx. 10,000 books were checked out this year!**
 - **89 Royal Readers participated! They were treated to a Breakfast and prizes!**
 - **Mrs. McIntosh reported that the library is kid-friendly and we all agreed our library is a wonderful collection of resources for students and teachers alike!**
 4. **Teaching Schedule Update...at time of meeting, it was still in progress. Mrs. Dwairi added that Kerr has been designated as an intradistrict transfer school for legitimate day care reasons, and our school will be capped at 1200.**
 5. **Site Council Elections will take place at first meeting next year. Some incoming parents have expressed an interest to Mrs. Dwairi.**
- **New Business**
 1. **Darren McKinney made 2 requests to Site Council:**
 - a) **He requested \$1440 for new volleyball standards for P.E. and competitive volleyball. Gaile Heieck made the motion to get the poles rejuvenated; Louie Mehas seconded it and the motion was carried.**
 - b) **Mr. McKinney also requested money to take a U.C. Davis History Project workshop. Ms. Dwairi is checking on how to fund this, since we cannot use SIP money for a workshop next year.**
