A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE
ELK GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

RESOLUTION ELIMINATING / REDUCING CLASSIFIED POSITIONS

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended to this Board that it eliminate the classified positions listed below due to lack of work and/or lack of funds; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this Resolution to accept the recommendation and to order the elimination/reduction of the positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY FOUND, ORDERED, AND RESOLVED as follows:

1. This Board hereby determines that there is a lack of work and/or a lack of funds and therefore orders the reduction/elimination of the following positions:
 - a. Library Technician, various elementary school sites (AFSCME) – three 8-hour per day positions reducing to 7-hour per day positions. (Effective June 30, 2008)
 - b. Library Technician, various elementary school sites (AFSCME) – twelve 6-hour per day positions reducing to 5-hour per day positions. (Effective June 30, 2008)
 - c. Library Technician, various elementary school sites (AFSCME) – eleven 5-hour per day positions reducing to 4-hour per day positions. (Effective June 30, 2008)
 - d. Library Technician, Anna Kirchgater Elementary School (AFSCME) – one 7-hour per day position reducing to a 6-hour per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)
 - e. Library Technician, Prairie Elementary School (AFSCME) – one 7-hour and 38-minute per day position reducing to a 6-hour and 38-minute per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)
 - f. Library Technician, Beitzel Elementary School (AFSCME) – one 5-hour and 24-minute per day position reducing to a 4-hour and 24-minute per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)

- g. Library Technician, Joseph Sims Elementary School (AFSCME) – one 6-hour and 30- minute per day position reducing to a 5-hour and 30-minute per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)
- h. Library Technician, Edna Batey Elementary School (AFSCME) –one 4-hour and 30-minute per day position reducing to a 4-hour per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)

- m. Office Assistant I, Student Support & Health Services (AFSCME) funded by Foster Youth – one 1-hour and 21-minute per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)
- n. Program Assistant, Student Support & Health Services (AFSCME) funded by Foster Youth – two 8-hour per day positions. (Effective June 30, 2008)
- o. School Secretary, Special Programs, Teacher Education Institute (Administrative Support) one 8-hour per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)
- p. Child Associate, Student Support & Health Services (CSEA) funded by Early Mental Health Initiative Grants – twenty-eight 3-hour per day positions. (Effective June 30, 2008)
- q. Family Advocate, Early Childhood Education (CSEA) funded by Bridging – one 8-hour per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)
- r. Instructional Assistant-General, Cosumnes River Elementary (CSEA) funded by PTA – one 3-hour per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)



- nn. Teaching Associate-Bilingual, Charles Mack Elementary (CSEA) – one 6-hour per day position. (Effective June 30, 2008)


