<p><b><u>Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 500 Scholarship</u></b> <a href="http://www.norcaltrav.com/vva500.htm">www.norcaltrav.com/vva500.htm</a></p> <p>4/ \$500. scholarships awarded in honor of all of the fallen brothers and sisters lost in the Vietnam War.</p> <p>Open to graduates of high school and/or holders of a GED that will attend a college, university or vocational school in 2009, or those already attending college or school.</p> <p>Must be a dependent or relative as such of a Vietnam Era Veteran (Jan 1, 1959 - May 7, 1975). Relative may be a spouse, child, grandchild, nephew or niece. Must provide a copy of the Veteran's DD214 or submit proof of military service.</p> <p>Requires a copy of student's paid registration to an accredited school, college or university. Must submit 300-1000 Word Essay with a cover page listing the following :name, name of high school, evidence of holding a GED or attendance at college or vocational school, personal address, phone number, e-mail, name of college, university or school will be attending in the fall and your educational goals. Essay Topic:"Interview three Vietnam Combat Veterans. Tell their stories. Where did they serve and in what branch? What did they think of the war while serving?
