Requires - completed application including description of participation in extra-curricular and/or community-related activities, official transcript, 500-750 word essay that includes a self-description and explains "Why you would like to pursue a career in the transportation field". Letters of recommendation will be considered.

Open to current 2 year college students and high school seniors planning to attend two-year degree granting institutions in the fall following HS graduation.

Must be US citizen or permanent resident, with a 2.5 GPA planning to enroll in at least 2 courses during the fall term at a 2-year, degree granting institution, who is actively engaged in volunteer service or employed at least part-time.

### **Nordstrom Scholarship Award Program**

**1-Jun-09**

5/\$10,000. awarded to students in the Bay Area / Sacramento Region (paid in 4 equal installments of \$2,500. over 4-year period)

Eligibility - Open to JUNIORS with a minimum un-weighted cum GPA of 2.7 who have made a substantial contribution to community service, are involved in school activities, and have the financial need for a scholarship. Must be eligible to attend a 4-year college or university in the U.S.; and must attend an accredited 4-year college or university during all years for which the scholarship is awarded. Can not have a conviction for any crime.

Requires - completed application including a personal statement, an official copy of their high school transcript, a financial statement, an essay of no more than 500 words on a designated topic, and a letter of recommendation from a current teacher/ counselor/ faculty member. If chosen as a finalist, student will be asked to participate in an interview.

### **Gordon Stafford Scholarship**

Renewable Scholarship to benefit minority students pursuing an Architecture degree at a school or college with an architecture program accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board. Must be enrolled as a first-year or transfer student, pursuing an Architecture Degree. (A complete list of accredited schools programs on [www.naab.org](http://www.naab.org)) Scholarship recipients who are progressing successfully toward their degree will continue to receive a \$2000. stipend annually for a maximum of five years while pursuing their degree.

Requires - application, maximum 500-word statement of the candidate's desire to pursue a career in Architecture, demonstration of minority status, a copy of an acceptance letter from an NAAB accredited architecture program. Applicant must have a permanent California residence address.
