Personal Mastery: Making oneself better; 2. Leadership: Making one's teammates better; 3. | <p><u>The STEP UP Positive Change Awards</u></p> <p>3 winners; 1/ \$500. 1/ \$300. 1/\$200.</p> <p>Program focuses on encouraging youth to be active, be positive and be informed and offers a scholarship not based strictly on academics, but rather on significant and productive life changes made by at-risk youth. Objective is to recognize youth who are often overlooked by mainstream society.</p> <p>Eligibility - California resident, aged 16-25 who has bade a significant and lasting life change. Ideal candidates are youth who may have been in trouble in the past but are making significant strides to improve their lives and their communities. Candidates need to be actively involved as a member , employee, or volunteer in an outreach program, sports & activities or non-profit organization.</p> <p>Requires - Completed Application Form and Questionnaire; Letter of recommendation from a director/supervisor of the organization the individual is actively involved in needs to be included in the application, as well.</p> | 6-May-10 |
| <p><u>Nordstrom Scholarship Award Program</u></p> <p>5/\$10,000. awarded to students in the Bay Area / Sacramento Region (paid in 4 equal installments of \$2,500. over 4-year period)</p> <p>Eligibility - Open to JUNIORS with a minimum un-weighted cum GPA of 2.7 who have made a substantial contribution to community service, are involved in school activities, and have the financial need for a scholarship. Must be eligible to attend a 4-year college or university in the U.S.; and must attend an accredited 4-year college or university during all years for which the scholarship is awarded. Can not have a conviction for any crime.</p> <p>Requires - completed application including a personal statement, an official copy of their high school transcript, a financial statement, an essay of no more than 500 words on a designated topic, and a letter of recommendation from a current teacher/ counselor/ faculty member. If chosen as a finalist, student will be asked to participate in an interview.</p> | 15-May-10 |

Scholarship</p> <p>Applicants must be high school seniors (or first or second year college students) in any of the District 11 counties (includes Sacto. County), seeking to pursue a career in transportation. - Students related to Caltrans' employees ARE NOT PROHIBITED from applying</p> <p>Eligibility - Student must be pursuing a career in transportation requiring college instruction or vocational training. Must demonstrate involvement in school, extracurricular, or community activites, Financial need will be a consideration, but is not a primary factor</p> <p>Requires - completed application including description of participation in extra-curricular and/or community-related activities, official transcript, 500-750 word essay that includes a self-description and explains "Why you would like to pursue a career in the transportation field". Eligibility - Applicant must be a Vietnam Veteran or a dependent or relative of a Vietnam Veteran (relative may be a spouse, son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, nephew or niece; Provide a copy of the Veteran's DD214 or submit proof of military service; Be enrolled in at least 12 academic units per quarter/semester during the year of the scholarship award.

Requires - Completed application form; An essay of 500 words or fewer on the following topic: "Talk to Vietnam Veterans (as many as possible), and compile their experiences on their return home the Good, the Bad, the Ugly, and the Beautiful"; Official transcript; A list of extracurricular or community activities; 2 Letters of recommendation from individuals who are not related to the applicant.

Open to graduates of high school and/or holders of a GED that will attend a college, university or vocational school in 2010, or those already attending college or school.

Must be a dependent or relative as such of a Vietnam Era Veteran (Jan 1, 1959 - May 7, 1975). Relative may be a spouse, child, grandchild, nephew or niece. Must provide a copy of the Veteran's DD214 or submit proof of military service.

Requires a copy of student's paid registration to an accredited school, college or university. Must submit 300-1000 Word Essay with a cover page listing the following :name, name of high school, evidence of holding a GED or attendance at college or vocational school, personal address, phone number, e-mail, name of college, university or school will be attending in the fall and your educational goals. Essay Topic:"Interview three Vietnam Combat Veterans. Tell their stories. Where did they serve and in what branch? What did they think of the war while serving? What did they think of the war in later years? Did they have any injuries or long lasting effects from the Vietnam War?"
