The Living History Project will provide approximately 100 hours of history professional development through a series of four Friday afternoon (4:00-8:00 p.m.), Saturday (8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.) workshop sessions. The series will teach content directly related to the study of liberty and rights. Participants will work in site teams to develop lesson plans for classroom/district use by the end of the series and participants will travel to Alabama for the summer institute.
