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Learning Model Preference Survey for 2021-2022

Providing equitable and high quality instruction while keeping students, families and staff as safe as possible remains our priority.

In order to best plan for the 2021-2022 school year we need learning model preference information. We realize it can be challenging to select a preference when things as yet remain uncertain. We greatly appreciate your understanding and willingness to complete these surveys as your real time feedback is vitally important for our planning and decision making.

You are asked to select one of three options for each of your children to express your preference. **This is not a final selection for the 2021-2022 school year.** This is essential information for the District to have in order to finalize plans for the upcoming school year.

1. **Full return to school** - five days per week during normal school hours
2. **Elk Grove Unified School District Virtual Academy** - Independent Study for K-8 grade students
 - a. Students are assigned to an EGUSD Virtual Academy teacher and use an online curriculum completed at home. Students are expected to spend 2-3 hours per week with their teacher individually or in small groups. This direct teacher time may be in- person, virtual, or other medium as agreed upon. Parents play a critical role as learning coaches in the Virtual Academy to support their students' learning.
3. **Las Flores High School** - Independent Study for 9-12 grade students
 - a. Students are assigned to a Las Flores independent study teacher and use an online curriculum completed at home. Students are expected to meet with their teachers for one hour per week. The meeting time may be in-person, virtual, or other medium as agreed upon. In person is preferred but not required. Additional academic support may be scheduled as needed.

Note: Distance Learning waivers were made possible for the current school year by the State given the pandemic conditions. Currently, there is no indication these same waivers will be in effect for the 2021-2022 school year for either full distance learning or the in-person concurrent model.
