We invite you and your student to use this website as a key resource to plan for life after high school, regardless of your child's post-secondary goals.

CaliforniaColleges.edu is a One-Stop-Shop for EGUSD students to plan for college and career. This website is free for all EGUSD students and their parents/caregivers and offers the following:

- ❖ **Academic Planner** that shows student courses and grades beginning in 9th grade (2nd semester)
- ❖ Quick and easy career quizzes
- ❖ Personal tab where students can save:
 - College lists
 - Career lists
 - Goals/journals
 - Experiences to prep for a resume
 - Letters of Recommendation/ Personal Essay/UC Personal Questions
- ❖ Opportunities for seniors to apply to:
 - CSUs and request to have all courses imported instead of hand entering them
 - CRC and have the option to share their transcript data for course placement
- ❖ Parents/caregivers with educational rights can view student's personal tabs (Parent editing is not available.)

When you connect to your student's CaliforniaColleges.edu account in 9th grade (2nd semester), you and your student will see transcript and class information in the **Academic Planner**. Additionally, you and your student will be able to see how the classes your student has completed are preparing him/her to meet CSU or UC eligibility requirements. Furthermore, your student will be able to review and save items in the tab **My Plan** such as **My Career Plan/My Colleges/My Experiences/My Documents/My Journal** and set or complete pre-set goals in **My Goals**. Once your student has saved such information, you as an educational right's holder, will be able to review and support your student in creating their post-secondary plan using this saved information.

In order to connect to a student's CaliforniaColleges.edu account, educational rights holders will need to have an active email (ex.**Gmail.com** or **Comcast.net** email). If you need help in creating an email account, contact your student's school site for support. For a step-by-step to register your account and connect with your student's CaliforniaColleges.edu please review the reverse side of this letter.

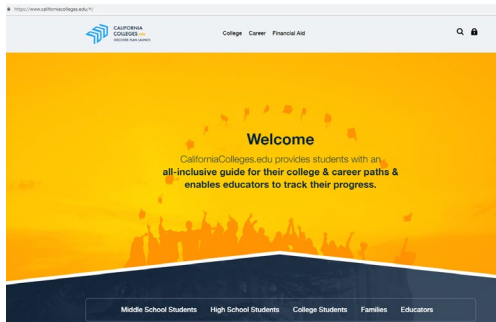

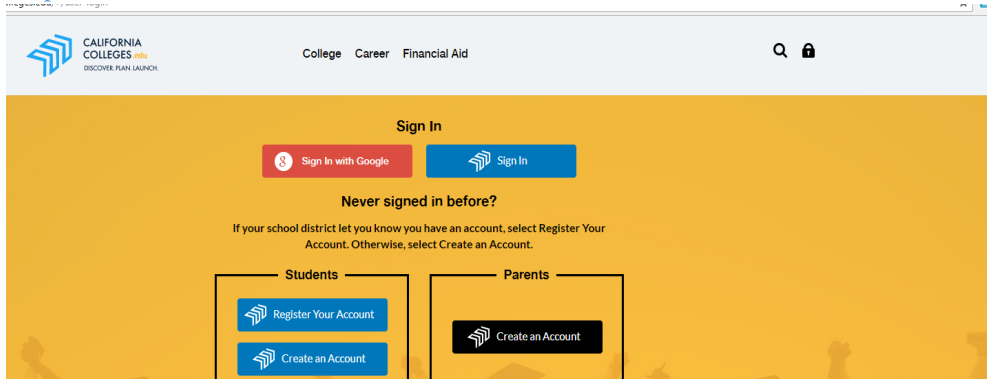
Step-By-Step Educational Right's Holder [CaliforniaColleges.edu](https://www.californiacolleges.edu) Registration

Step 1. Navigate to CaliforniaColleges.edu.

Step 2. Click on the lock icon (🔒) in the upper right-hand corner of the page.
