RESOLUTION FOR READOPTING AND INCREASING THE 2012-13 GANN LIMIT AND ADOPTING THE 2013-14 GANN LIMIT

#### **Action Requested:**

The Board is asked to adopt the attached Resolution #\_\_16\_\_, 2013-14, which 1) recalculates and increases the 2012-13 Gann Limit to \$340,008,945.12 and 2) establishes the 2013-14 estimated Gann Limit at \$397,884,936.85.

#### Discussion:

In 1989, the State enacted changes in statutory law (SB 98 and AB 198), Chapter 82 and 83, Statutes of 1989, which required a recalculation of the 1978-79 and 1988-89 Gann Limits for all California school districts. In June, 1990, the voters approved Proposition 111 which required another one-time adjustment to prior year Gann Limits. Accordingly, the Gann Limit for 1989-90 was recalculated at \$71,515,984. Each year we are now required to recalculate the prior year using actual data, and then estimate the Gann Limit for the budget year.

The Gann Appropriation Limit for 2012-13 has been recalculated at \$340,008,945.12 compared to appropriations of \$377,863,090.18 subject to the limit.

The 2013-14 estimated Gann Limit has been calculated at \$ 397,884,936.85.

The detailed calculations for Elk Grove Unified School District are attached.

#### Financial Summary:

No impact on the District's finances. If the District exceeds its Gann Limit, the excess is transferred to the State by law.

WHEREAS, in November 1979, the California electorate did adopt Proposition 4, commonly called the Gann Amendment, which added Article XIIIB to the California Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, the provisions of that Article establish maximum appropriations limits, commonly called "Gann Limits," for public agencies including school districts; and,

WHEREAS, the District must establish a Gann Limit for the 2012-13 fiscal year and a projected Gann Limit for the 2013-14 fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Article XIIIB and applicable statutory law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does provide public notice that the attached calculations and documentation of the Gann Limit for the 2012-13 and 2013-14 fiscal years are made in accord with applicable constitutional and statutory law;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board does hereby declare that the appropriations in the Budget for the 2012-13 and 2013-14 fiscal years do not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent provide copies of this resolution along with appropriate attachments to interested citizens of this District;
