MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE ELK GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, OCTOBER 3, 2023

OPEN SESSION: Ms. Chaires Espinoza called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. and provided a welcome and announced that live streaming of the board meeting is made available via the Zoom platform and meetings are recorded (video and audio) and will be made available on the Elk Grove Unified School District's YouTube channel at www.youtube.com/user/elkgroveunified

- I. Pledge of Allegiance Lori Raineri led the pledge of allegiance.
- **II. Overview of Day** Superintendent Hoffman provided an overview of the day and thanked staff for their hard work.
- III. Overview of District's School Facilities Funding The Board received information about school facilities funding from the district's public finance consultant, Government Financial Services Joint Powers Authority. The information included a review of the sources of funds available to the district for facilities, a discussion of the district's current debt portfolio for facilities including Measure M and Community Facilities District No. 1 was held and suggestions on how to raise additional funds were discussed.
- Ms. Chaires called for a break at 9:57 a.m. and called the meeting back to order at 10:04 a.m.
- IV. New and One-Time Funds Update Amari Watkins provided the Board with information regarding new and one-time funding sources and potential uses. Over the last several years, the federal government and the State of California provided many new funding allocations to school districts. EGUSD has spent some of these funds, such as federal ESSER III funding, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting impacts. The State awarded and funded two block grants, but subsequently reduced the awards as a part of the 2023-24 Budget Act. The current year's budget also includes new funding to support arts and music education and address historic disparities in student performance.

Board members provided feedback and thanked Ms. Watkins for the update.

- V. Review of Handbook and Board Protocols Board members reviewed the updates to the Governance Handbook that reflected suggestions made by board members. Board members provided feedback and gave direction to staff. This item will be brought back for approval at the October 17, 2023, board meeting.
