One-Time and New Funds Update Superintendent Hoffman and Dr. Kristen Coates provided an overview and recommendations for the use of the sunsetting Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Funds, the Learning Recovery Emergency Block Grant, and the Arts, Music & Instructional Materials Block Grant, as well as information on targeted one-time funds for arts and music education and closing the achievement gap. They provided input and feedback on the use of other one-time funding to carry forward the costs of personnel and other actions/services currently funded with ESSER funds that will expire in September 2024.

Public Comment: Teresa Nguyen spoke in support of the arts and asked that funding continue.

The Board provided feedback and thanked staff for the report.
