WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Unified School District's Foster Youth Services program, in collaboration with Elk Grove Unified School District teachers, administrators, and other staff members, provides targeted programs and services for students in foster care that leverage their assets, affirm their identities, and address their needs to close achievement, opportunity, and relationship gaps; and

WHEREAS, the Elk Grove Unified School District's staff members recognize the unique challenges faced by youth in foster care and are committed to increasing the level of awareness and improved outcomes by incorporating goals and supports in the school- and district-level Local Control Accountability Plans specifically for students in foster care;
