Community Meeting Process

1. Two Community Meetings were advertised as follows:

- Discussed and shared at all previous Board meetings and timelines.
- Posted on the District's Redistricting Website and Homepage.
- Shared in Community messages sent to all parents and staff and other tools utilized by the Communications Department.
- 2. Meetings were held on January 6, 2022 and January 13, 2022 via Zoom (originally planned to be in person and virtual).
- 3. Community Meeting materials were posted on Redistricting Website.

Community Meeting Content

- 1. Attendees received a detailed description of the process including the election system change.
- 2. Outreach and notification efforts were shared.
- 3. Attendees received a tutorial of the Redistricting Website, how to access the resources as well as the draft and interactive maps.
- 4. Attendees were encouraged throughout the presentation to ask questions and provide feedback both through the chat feature and to interact live through Zoom.
- 5.38 interested parties attended the meetings.



Community Meeting Feedback

- 1. Question regarding how the redistricting process would affect school boundaries and where their student(s) would attend school.
- 2. Question regarding how the process will increase student population for a particular school apparently related to downsizing.
- 3. Question about involving student government classes.
- 4. Feedback that appreciated the notion of population balance, but felt that was in place with the hybrid at large election system.
- 5. Concern about Trustees only being focused on their area and not the entire District. Concerned about taking power away from voters.



Community Meeting Feedback

- 6. Question about the County and if they have authority over these maps and if there is a process for them to approve or deny the map the Board approves and if they deny it, is there legal recourse for the District.
- 7. Question as to whether this will "fix" overflow or redirection of students from impacted schools.
- 8. No questions regarding the draft maps.
- 9. A preference was given for Draft Map 3 with no other preferences.



Proposed Redistricting Timeline

- November 16, 2021 (Board meeting) Initial information regarding redistricting process shared with the Board and the public.
- December 7, 2021 Draft maps posted.
- December 14, 2021 (Board meeting) Demographers presented their study of the 2020 Census data and draft map options.
- January 6, 2022 and January 13, 2022 Community input meetings.
- January 18, 2022 (Board meeting) Staff presents summary of community input.



Proposed Redistricting Timeline (con't)

- January 26, 2022 (Board meeting) Board considers map options. Possible map adoption.
- February 1, 2022 (Board meeting, optional) Possible map adoption.
- February 15, 2022 (Board meeting, optional) Possible map adoption.
- February 28, 2022 Statutory deadline for completion of the redistricting process.
