Air Quality Index - Particulate Matter

301-500	Hazardous
201–300	Very Unhealthy
151-200	Unhealthy
101–150	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups
51-100	Moderate
0-50	Good

□ 351-500 HAZARDOUS

• School Closure

□ 301-350 HAZARDOUS

• School districts may consider school closures

□ 201-300 VERY UNHEALTHY

- Outdoor athletic events cancelled
- Outdoor lunch and recesses cancelled
- Outdoor P.E. cancelled
- All activities should be moved indoors
- Keep doors closed while indoors

□ 151-200 UNHEALTHY

- Outdoor athletic events cancelled
- Outdoor lunch and recess cancelled
- Outdoor P.E. cancelled

□ 101-150 UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS

• Students diagnosed with respiratory conditions should be allowed to stay indoors and have access to their quick-relief medications
